- A one-time, non refundable application fee of \$50 US, do not send cash
- Final official transcripts (no copies) from all colleges, universities or professional schools which you have attended or currently attend. International transcripts* which must be evaluated (course by course) by one of the following agencies. The transcripts must demonstrate a US degree equivalency and a GPA of a 2.5 or higher.

- [TOEFL](#) (Test of English as a Foreign Language) scores are mandatory for most international students. The University TOEFL code is 5358. The following scores are acceptable for admission:
 - 500 or higher (Paper Based)
 - 173 or higher (Computer Based)
 - 61 or higher (Internet Based)
- [IELTS](#) (International English Language Testing System) Applicants may also be accepted with a minimum score of 5.5.

Applicants from the following country are exempt from the English language proficiency exam: *Australia, Bahamas, Barbados, some parts of Canada, Dominica, Ghana, Guyana, Ireland, Jamaica, Liberia, New Zealand, Sierra Leone, Tobago, Trinidad, United Kingdom, or Zimbabwe*
- Students who have received a four year degree from the United States are also exempt from an English language proficiency exam
- If less than 14 semester hours of college coursework Official SAT/ACT scores are required
- If transferring from another U.S. college or university, a SEVIS transfer eligibility form is required (please contact the Office of Enrollment for this form)
- [Financial statement](#) covering the first year of tuition and living expenses (please contact the Office of Enrollment for this form)
