- A one-time, non refundable application fee of \$50 US, do not send cash
- Final official transcripts (no copies) from all colleges, universities or professional schools which you have attended or currently attend sent directly to Life University (no exceptions)
- Official SAT/ACT scores. If you have less than 14 semester hours or 20 quarter hours of transferable college credit, you must submit recent (taken within 5 years) SAT/ACT scores
- Final official high school transcript or GED if you have less than 60 semester hours or less than 90 quarter hours of college course work
- Official CLEP scores sent directly to Life University (if applicable)
- Official advanced placement (AP) transcripts send directly to Life University (if applicable)
