- A signed copy of the 2013 IRS Form 1040X "Amended U.S. Individual Income Tax Return" that was filed with the IRS.

Instructions for the IRS Data Retrieval Tool: The best way to verify income is by using the IRS Data Retrieval Tool that is part of FAFSA on the Web.

- If the student or parent has not already used the tool, go to www.FAFSA.gov, log in to the student's FAFSA record, select "Make FAFSA Corrections," and navigate to the Financial Information section of the form. From there, follow the instructions to determine if the student or parent(s) are eligible to use the IRS Data Retrieval Tool to transfer 2013 IRS income tax information into the student's FAFSA.
- It takes up to two weeks for IRS income information to be available for the IRS Data Retrieval Tool for electronic IRS tax return filers, and up to eight weeks for paper IRS tax return filers.

Instructions for obtaining a 2013 IRS Tax Return Transcript: Keep in mind it takes up to two weeks for IRS income information to be available for electronic IRS tax return filers, and up to eight weeks for paper IRS tax return filers.

- Visit www.IRS.gov and click on "Get Transcript for My Tax Records." Make sure you indicate "Get Transcript Online" and create an account.
- Call 800-908-9946. Make sure to request the "IRS tax return transcript" and not the "IRS tax account transcript."
- Go to a Taxpayer Assistance Center found at www.irs.gov/uac/Contact-Your-Local-IRS-Office-1.

STUDENT AND/OR PARENT NONTAX FILERS:
