

QUARTERLY COST OF ATTENDANCE 2014-2015



Cost of Attendance is an estimate of the total amount it will cost you to go to school for an academic period. Cost of attendance includes tuition and fees, room and board or living expenses, allowances for books, supplies and transportation. The cost of attendance is determined by the school using guidelines established by federal regulations. (also known as Cost of Education or Student Budget)

PLANNING AND FORECASTING THE NUMBERS:

To figure out your tuition and fee charges:

$$\# \text{ of credits} \times \$ \text{ tuition per credit (by program)} = \text{_____} + \$350 \text{ quarterly fee} = \$ \text{ Total tuition and fees for a quarter}$$

To figure out what your estimated refund or balance would be:

$$\text{Total tuition and fees for a quarter} - \text{Awarded financial aid (do not include work study)} = \text{Estimated credit or balance}$$
