ESTABLISHING GEORGIA RESIDENCY



To be eligible for state funds, residency must be verified. You must document established domicile in the State of Georgia. Enrolling at LU directly from high school requires at least one year of domicile and enrolling not directly from high school requires at least 2 years of domicile. Determining a student's residency status must be based on the existence of surrounding objective circumstances that indicate a student's intent to maintain a permanent residence, or domicile, in the State of Georgia.

DOCUMENTING GEORGIA RESIDENCY

Entering Life University not directly from high school:

You must show established domicile in Georgia for at least two years prior to the first term of attendance at Life University.

Residency documents must be dated based on the first quarter enrolled at Life University:

Both types of students must submit **two (2)** documents to prove Georgia residency. **At least one form must be a primary document.** The second can be either a primary or secondary document. Below is a list of acceptable documents.

Dependent students are required to submit parents' residency documentation.

PRIMARY DOCUMENTATION

- Georgia driver's license (issue date can be older than 3 years from the first day of the quarter as long as it has not expired)
- · Georgia vehicle registration
- Georgia state tax return (W-2s or Federal tax returns are not acceptable)
- · Georgia voter registration card
- · Military records
- · Property tax receipts

SECONDARY DOCUMENTATION

- Utility bill (cell phone bill is not acceptable)
- · Mortgage or lease agreement
- · Bank statement

• Employment verification: submit a letter (on letterhead) from employer stating dates of employment (pay stubs are not acceptable)
