Determining a student's residency status must be based on the existence of surrounding objective circumstances that indicate a student's intent to maintain a permanent residence, or domicile, in the State of Georgia.

- Georgia state tax return (W-2s or Federal tax returns are not acceptable)
- · Georgia voter registration card
- Military records
- · Property tax receipts

SECONDARY DOCUMENTATION

- Utility bill (cell phone bill is not acceptable)
- Mortgage or lease agreement
- · Bank statement

• Employment verification: submit a letter (on letterhead) from employer stating dates of employment (pay stubs are not acceptable)
