

ESTABLISHING GEORGIA RESIDENCY FORM 2022-2023

To be eligible for state funds, residency must be verified. You must document established domicile in the State of Georgia. Enrolling at LU directly from high school requires at least one year of domicile and enrolling not directly from high school requires **at least 2 years** of domicile. Determining a student's residency status must be based on the existence of surrounding objective circumstances that indicate a student's intent to maintain a permanent residence, or domicile, in the State of Georgia.

- Required for GTEG: In order to be eligible for this grant, you must have full-time enrollment through the end of the add/drop period each quarter.

Entering Life University not directly from high school:

You must show established domicile in Georgia for at least two years prior to the first term of attendance at Life University.

Residency documents must be dated based on the first quarter enrolled at Life University:

2021-2022

- Summer 2021: 1/1/18 to 6/30/19
- Fall 2021: 4/1/18 to 9/30/19
- Winter 2022: 6/1/19 to 12/31/20
- Spring 2022: 10/1/19 to 3/31/20

2022-2023

- Summer 2022: 1/1/19 to 6/30/20
- Fall 2022: 4/1/19 to 9/30/20
- Winter 2023: 6/1/20 to 12/31/21
- Spring 2023: 10/1/20 to 3/31/21

Both types of students must submit **two (2)** documents to prove Georgia residency. **At least one form must be a primary document.** The second can be either a primary or secondary document. You cannot submit two of the same type of document from the primary category. Below is a list of acceptable documents.

Dependent students are required to submit parents' residency documentation.

PRIMARY DOCUMENTATION

- Georgia driver's license (issue date can be older than 3 years from the first day of the quarter as long as it has not expired)
- Georgia voter registration card
- Georgia vehicle registration
- Military records
- Georgia state tax return (W-2s or Federal tax returns are not acceptable)
- Property tax receipts

SECONDARY DOCUMENTATION

- Utility bill (cell phone bill is not acceptable)
- Employment verification: submit a letter (on letterhead) from employer stating dates of employment (pay stubs are not acceptable)
- Mortgage or lease agreement
- Bank statement
