EXIT COUNSELING



Students who received a Perkins, PLUS or Direct Loan and were enrolled at Life University are required by federal law to complete an exit interview. The exit interview helps you understand your rights and responsibilities as a student loan borrower. It also provides useful tips and information to help you manage your loans and explain repayment options.

You are not required to complete the exit interview if you did not borrow a Perkins, PLUS or Direct Loan or are continuing a new program next quarter at Life University.

DIRECT AND GRADUATE PLUS LOAN EXIT:

- · Go to www.StudentLoans.gov and log in
- You will need your FSA ID and password to log on
- · Click Complete Counseling and choose option Exit Counseling, select Life University
- You must complete the entire interview and you are advised to complete the entire session in one setting; the information is not saved if you do not.

The exit session will discuss information about repayment with a detailed loan summary. This will include your most current data from NSLDS and give you an estimated repayment schedule under each repayment plan.

- · You must complete the entire interview

The purpose of this exit interview is to explain your rights and responsibilities under the Perkins Loan program, and to provide the loan servicer required borrower information to properly service your loan until it is paid in full.
