

# INTERNATIONAL APPLICATION CHECKLIST



**The following documents must be received by the Office of Enrollment by the quarterly deadline (90 days prior to the start of the quarter):**

- Fall Quarter:** Begins October 3 • Application Deadline is July 1  
**Winter Quarter:** Begins January 7 • Application Deadline is October 1  
**Spring Quarter:** Begins April 1 • Application Deadline is January 1  
**Summer Quarter:** Begins July 15 • Application Deadline is April 1

- Application completed online or paper copy ([www.LIFE.edu](http://www.LIFE.edu))
- A one-time, non-refundable application fee of \$50 US; do not send cash
- International transcripts\* must be evaluated by one of the following agencies, and must demonstrate a US degree equivalency and a GPA of a 2.0 or higher

For the Doctor of Chiropractic program, transcripts must be evaluated course by course, including a grade point average of 2.5 and 3.0 for Master's

\*Some Canadian institutions do not need to be evaluated—please contact the Office of Enrollment for this list

- TOEFL (Test of English as a Foreign Language) scores are mandatory for most international students\* (the University TOEFL code is 5358); the following scores are acceptable for admission:
  - 61 or higher (Internet-based)

**OR**

- IELTS (International English Language Testing System) Applicants may also be accepted with a minimum score of 5.5

\*Applicants from the following countries are exempt from the English language proficiency exam: *Australia, Bahamas, Barbados, some parts of Canada, Dominica, Ghana, Guyana, Ireland, Jamaica, Liberia, New Zealand, Sierra Leone, Tobago, Trinidad, United Kingdom and Zimbabwe*

Students who have received a four-year degree from the United States are also exempt from an English language proficiency exam

**AND**

- If fewer than 14 semester hours of college coursework, official SAT/ACT with essays scores are required. To find out more information, please visit [collegeboard.org](http://collegeboard.org).
- I-20 request form.
- If transferring from another US college or university, a SEVIS transfer eligibility form is required
- Financial statement covering the first year of tuition and living expenses

- Copies of visa and passport
- U.S. arrival information
- Orientation registration
