

# QUARTERLY COST OF ATTENDANCE 2018-2019



Cost of Attendance (COA) is an *estimate* of the total amount it may cost you to go to school for an academic period. The COA (or financial aid budget) is not a budget comprised of your personal expenses but are educational expenses that the government considers to be related to the pursuit of a degree or certificate. COA includes tuition and fees, room & board or living expenses, allowances for books & supplies, personal expenses, loan fees and transportation. **The COA is determined by the school using guidelines established by federal regulations.**

Life University is a private institution and has the same tuition per program for all students, whether they have in-state or out-of state residency. **All students are charged a quarterly administrative fee of \$497.** This fee includes, but is not limited to: information technology, ePrint, parking, campus shuttles, lab fees, graduation, orientation, wellness center, intramural and club activities. **Amounts effective Summer 2018.**
