Pre-chiropractic Program

The University of Charleston has partnered with Life University to offer a prechiropractic program. The State of West Virginia Board of Chiropractic requires a BS degree prior to applicants enrolling in a chiropractic institution to be eligible to sit for licensure in West Virginia. This is not a State law. The Board has decided that it can make exceptions and has approved the articulation agreement between Life & the University of Charleston.

The agreement allows students to attend the University of Charleston for a three year prechiropractic education prior to enrolling in Life's chiropractic program. Thus, this will save students who follow this route one academic year of time and expense.
