Associate Professor of Communication Sciences & Disorders; Director of the Center for Ed. Neuroscience Applications

In addition to being a full-time university faculty member, I also provide speech and language diagnostic and treatment services; consult with school districts and physicians on complex cases; and provide professional development opportunities to schools, hospitals and other professional institutions. My workshops and seminars cover a wide range of topics related to communication disorders; neurobiology and neurophysiology of learning, effect of sleep and cognition, behavior and learning; role of emotions in memory & learning; neurobiology of ethnic and racial discrimination; neurobiology of ADHD and Executive Functions, and many other topics. I am also the founder and Director of the Center for Educational Neuroscience Applications (CENA) at Bridgewater State University. The goal of this center is to bridge the gap between neuroscience and education, and between neuroscience and clinical practice. We work to enable professors, allied health clinicians and school teachers to modernize teaching and clinical practice.
