**FROM: Emergency Action Task Force (EATF)**

As was communicated by President Dr. Rob Scott on Tuesday morning, Life University is closely monitoring ongoing developments related to the COVID-19 (Coronavirus) outbreak and its potential impact on the LIFE community.

In accordance, Life University's Emergency Action Task Force (EATF) is meeting regularly and staying abreast of continual updates on all things related to the virus, while making appropriate plans and procedures for the University in the unlikely event that COVID-19 becomes a more immediate risk to our campus community. The task force is following Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) guidelines as well as obtaining information from the Georgia Department of Public Health and Cobb and Douglas Public Health.

Ultimately, it is important to remember that while the CDC considers COVID-19 as a serious public health concern, it represents a low immediate risk to the American public at this time.

Currently there are no confirmed cases of coronavirus at Life University and fewer than five in the state of Georgia.

Be assured that any important updates regarding COVID-19 and its potential impact on the LIFE community will be disseminated if or when they arise.
